


BOUND TOGETHER by COMPASSION

At Virginia Baptist Homes, benevolence is provided through financial assistance, as well as the services and amenities available 24 hours a day with ease of access for our residents. These acts of benevolence are provided to strengthen the independence and self-worth of residents.

As we look back over the generations, care has often been provided by families. Today, with families living thousands of miles away, career and family obligations, and the differences between the lifestyles of the senior adult and their adult children and grandchildren, this support is often difficult, sometimes impossible, and can result in tremendous stress on family relationships.

All aspects of benevolent care are important in the lives of our residents. Seniors move to our communities for a variety of reasons. Many are interested in planning for future care or are tiring of maintaining a house. Within the first few days of settling in their new home, it is typical for new residents to feel that they have found a safe haven among neighbors and staff.

For instance:

- Uncertainty is replaced with a plan for their future.
- Being alone is replaced with having neighbors who share similar interests.
- Struggling to find reliable help is replaced with the caring service of dedicated staff 24 hours a day.
- The uncertainty of not knowing who will come if they need assistance is replaced with a call that brings to their side staff who know them well.
- Concern about driving is replaced with convenient transportation.

 Hesitancy to call on family or friends to pick up items at the grocery store or the pharmacy, take them to a physical therapy appointment, etc. is replaced with a short stroll down the hall to take care of these daily activities on their own.

These services and amenities are primary to the benevolence of care provided for residents every day in our four communities.

We are sincerely grateful for the many acts of benevolence—from easing financial burden of a resident to the offering of a helping hand—through the Christian love shown by those who support this ministry enabling Virginia Baptist Homes to continue its mission and ministry.


happy—I say happiness happens when one gives of oneself.



"There's no reason to be bored here—if you are it's your own fault," he says. It's a close community of people who enjoy each other; no one is isolated.

He can cook, but loves to eat in the CBRC dining room with his friends. "The staff are wonderful people. They make living here so much better," adds Bernie.

When asked why he became a President's Circle member with his first charitable gift a few years ago, he said he wanted to show the staff his appreciation for the work on the grounds around his home. He chuckles as he says, "The world didn't come to an end and I felt good about it, so I'll keep doing it as long as I can."

"The Community has taken care of me over the years, so I want to give something back. I firmly believe in the ministry. It's a good life here," he adds as we say goodbye.

Not Retired from Living

Franklin and Dorcas Fowler have long been an integral part of the Lakewood Manor community. This year they helped to make a lasting mark to further beautify the campus. After they moved to Lakewood in 1987, they noticed that many of the residents could not go to church because they were no longer driving and their church did not send a bus or those churches that did send a bus could not get wheelchairs on the bus.

They began a ministry with short services in Healthcare "...Dorcas played and I preached," said Fowler. As time went by, they began to receive more help from other retired pastors.

In 2007, the services were moved to the newly constructed Health Services Building. The room was spacious but the walls were blank. Their daughter, Lindon Rice, who is an interior designer, attended a service with them and agreed that something should be done to beautify the room. They needed a beautiful place to worship that would also accommodate other activities.


In addition to their worship ministry, Dr. Fowler had been painting pictures of the flowers found at Lakewood. Over the years, their wonderful collection of paintings grew. They decided to donate these images to the community.

With this simple idea, the Health Services Beautification project got started. The campaign was successful and raised \$20,000 needed for renovations. Colorful stained glass windows were designed using the flower paintings for inspiration. They offer soft light that inspire residents during worship and other activities. Now that the room is finished, it is full every Sunday with 40-50 residents coming to worship.

The Fowlers remind us of the importance of these services; for many in the room it will be the last worship service that they will attend.

"Some people are not with us mentally but could sing the hymns from memory so it's a ministry," said Dr. Fowler. Dorcas has taken great pleasure over the years in never knowing a stranger at Lakewood. "One of the most rewarding things that I have done here is to get to know and greet everyone. I simply say "I don't know you, but I am Dorcas Fowler. I just greet people and that is my ministry," said Mrs. Fowler. Dr. Fowler chuckled, "People ask me all the time who I am and I just tell them that I am Dorcas' husband; then they know who I am."

The Fowlers have been involved with life at Lakewood since the day they moved in. "We may be retired but we are not retired from living," said Mrs. Fowler.

Caring and Sharing

Soon after my wife, Barbara, and I reached age 70 (1991) in our journey through life, we began thinking of settling into a more comfortable living arrangement. In the summer of 1999, A. Woodfin Patrick, a member of VBH Board of Trustees who is now deceased. suggested that we explore the possibilities of The Chesapeake in nearby Newport News. We visited the campus a few days later and found a most friendly and professional staff who treated residents as family. At the encouragement of our two sons, both dentists, we selected a new apartment that was under construction and scheduled for completion in the summer of 2003.

However, in April 2000, my wife underwent triple bypass surgery and several days later suffered a major stroke. Extensive therapy enabled her to regain some of her physical strength, but her speech never completely returned. During this period, we had the assistance of a nursing assistant during the day. As our apartment neared completion, we began the process of selling our home and downsizing for a move-in on October 27, 2003. This was one of the best decisions that we ever made.

We lived happily in our apartment for almost six years until Barbara's health began to deteriorate. We participated in numerous activities—fitness, church, travel, gardening, games, and more. Everyone is so kind and friendly, which creates an atmosphere of love and caring. Several of our friends visited us periodically and they also discovered the sense of closeness and belonging here. Some of them have become residents themselves and have had the same wonderful experiences that we have enjoyed.

In January 2010, Barbara's mental condition declined sharply and she was transferred to the Memory Support Unit at The Chesapeake. It was traumatic, but God works in mysterious ways. Just before her move, we visited the unit to see first-hand what it would be like. As we entered, the first person who greeted her was the Nursing Assistant who had worked with us in Hampton a few years earlier. This made a difficult situation much smoother and everyone gave Barbara a big welcome. She has become well-adjusted in the unit and loves everyone there. They all love her as well, and it is a precious blessing to have her in such a first class place for people in her condition.

I still live in our same apartment and visit my wife daily to do personal things with and for her—laundry, walking, watching television, and other activities. She gets 24-hour nursing care and I have the peace of mind knowing that she is in good hands. I use the fitness center regularly to enhance my own physical condition and longevity.

The beauty of living at The Chesapeake is that it provides a lifestyle for any medical condition a resident may have. As we grow older, what a pleasure and privilege it is to live in an environment that provides security and benefits for us to complete our earthly life's journey.
